The following are some of the services available at MAHEC Internal Medicine to patients from age 18 and through geriatric care:

- Diagnosis and management of chronic medical problems in the adult patient

 - Diseases of the pituitary gland, including acromegaly (excessive production of growth hormone); Cushing's disease; underactive pituitary or hypopituitarism
 - Diseases of the adrenal gland, including adrenal insufficiency; Addison's disease; congenital adrenal hyperplasia (CAH, a group of genetic disorders that affect the adrenal glands);
 Cushing's syndrome
 - Hyperprolactinemia (condition in which levels of the hormone prolactin are higher than normal)
 - Polycystic ovary syndrome (PCOS)
 - Male hypogonadism and erectile dysfunction
