
Expanding Access to Care & Treatment (EXACT)

Goal: increase access to care for individuals with opioid use disorder (OUD) who are un-/underinsured and at high risk for overdose (OD) death by providing low-barrier access to medication for OUD (MOUD) and outpatient treatment services in a primary care clinic.


Participant Profiles




Cumulative Appointments Attended:

Referral Sources






23 participants were screened for HIV/Hepatitis C while engaged in care: 13 participants screened positive and were referred to MAHEC's Next Step Clinic

Engaged in Care at: $\frac{3 \text{ Months}}{83}$ $\frac{6 \text{ Months}}{54}$ $\frac{9 \text{ Months}}{31}$ $\frac{12 \text{ Months}}{13}$ (59%) (38%) (22%) (9%)

On average, participants engaged in care for about 4 and a half months.

- No Fatal ODs were reported among Active Participants
- 3 participants reported an OD event at their 3-month reassessment
- No participants reported an OD event at their 6-, 9-, or 12-month reassessments
