MAHEC's Department of Health Careers and Diversity Education, the WNC Regional Advisory Committee (RAC) and the University of North Carolina at Asheville (UNCA), invite you to participate in the **Don C. Locke Health Career Expo (HCE)** portion of the 24th Annual Health Careers Education Awareness Conference. The conference will take place on **Tuesday, October 10, 2023 at** UNC Asheville's Sherrill Center. The **Expo is scheduled from 8:30a.m. to 10:30 a.m.**

What is the Health Careers Education

Awareness Conference? The conference continues to provide information, resources and education to high school students interested in pursuing a career in healthcare. At least 350 - 400 students are expected to attend from the 16 westernmost counties of North Carolina plus over 100 healthcare professionals, educators, community leaders and health science students. This conference is also designed to build linkages and partnerships with and between the education and healthcare communities.

What is the Health Career Expo?

The Expo provides a one-on-one forum for students to interact directly with health care professionals and health science students. Over 40 healthcare professions are represented with display booths, information, tools of the trade and representatives present to educate and inform students about what it is like to work in a particular career, what is required academically and the real life realities of work. Students visit career booths they are interested in pursuing as well as being exposed to careers they may have little knowledge of.

There cost for exhibitors to participate in the HCE is \$50.

PREPARATION AND TIPS

Here are some tips for success:

Before the Conference:

- **Know your audience** 9th through 12th graders from western NC counties. Remember what it was like to be a student!
- **Create a display** about your health care occupation
- Educate your booth representative(s) - be ready to answer questions about the occupation's work environment, educational and experience requirements, your personal experiences and community involvement.

At the Conference:

- **Provide handouts** about the occupation and your organization (business cards, brochures, etc.).
- **Make it interesting!** Have physical objects that students can touch, feel or observe related to your occupation.
- Be proactive and **interact with students**.
