Asheville, NC | June 20, 2023 — The CEO of Mountain Area Health Education Center was the featured speaker at the June 20 meeting of the Rotary Club of Highlands. William "Bill" Hathaway, MD, provided members an overview of MAHEC, the largest nonprofit employer in Western North Carolina:

- MAHEC educates and trains current and future healthcare professionals through its residency and fellowship programs, continuing professional development courses, and student pathway programs. Fully one-third of family medicine doctors in Western North Carolina were trained at MAHEC.
- MAHEC provides patient care through multidisciplinary teams that work together to address
 patients' physical, mental, and emotional needs across the lifespan as well as non-medical
 drivers of health. MAHEC has family medicine, ob/gyn, internal medicine, psychiatry and mental
 wellness, and dental clinics in numerous locations in Buncombe County and beyond, as well as
 two community pharmacies.
- MAHEC partners with community-based organizations and those most impacted to improve equitable access to opportunities for well-being.

In the academic year 2022-2023, 185 physicians, dentists, and pharmacists trained in MAHEC's graduate medical education programs. There were more than 100,000 attendees at MAHEC continuing professional development programs.
